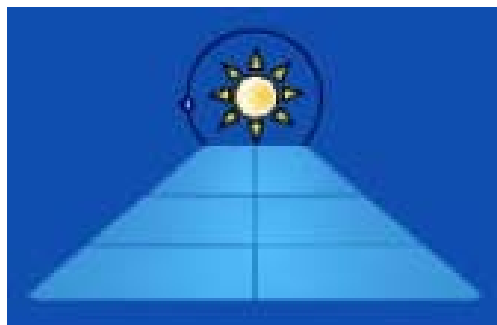


PATH Welcomes the Sociedad Mexicana del Hidrogeno!
