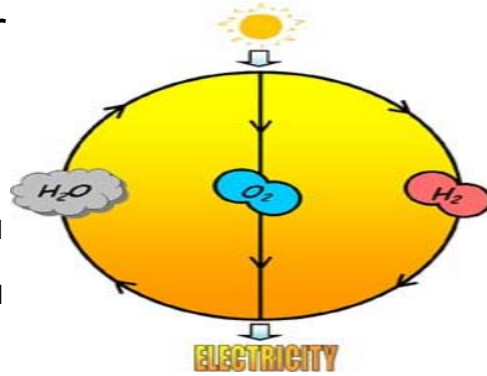


PATH's Progress in the Past Year
